

Care & Safety

- Riders who ride on the wrong side of the road will face disqualification, injury or worse.
- On the entry to Goring there is a Pinch Point where oncoming traffic has priority.
- There are Speed Bumps through Goring village. These are safe to ride over. Do not change your line.
- There will be Parked Cars at the Village Shop in Goring. Pass with care.
- There is a Pedestrian Crossing on exit from Goring. This will be marshalled, but if the lights are red you must stop.
- At the Finish Area, Do Not Stop. Carry straight on to the HQ.

Course Directions



From the start at Woodcote Village Hall, proceed North on the B471 to the junction with A4074 and turn left (CAUTION) towards Wallingford. Continue on A4074 for 6km then turn sharp left (CAUTION) onto B4009 towards North Stoke. Pass through North Stoke and South Stoke and proceed to Goring where road becomes B4526. Turn left (CAUTION) just before Goring Station and climb Flint Hill towards Crays Pond. At the staggered cross-roads at Crays Pond, turn left into B471 and continue on to Woodcote to complete one lap of 19.2km.

The feed zone is on the B4526 after the boundary of Goring village.

The finish and any primes will be on the B471 at the edge of Woodcote village.
